

Status of ISC Data Base Inventory for the Fisheries Related with Marlines and Swordfish¹

Statistical working group handles the ISC fisheries statistics as Categories I, II and III provided from each country/entity. The Working Group has proposed data format for submission of each Category data (Attachment 5 in Report of STAT-WG 2002). These data is made available to contributors only and to authorized scientists of ISC working groups, except for public domain data posted on the ISC web site (Report of STAT-WG 2002). The Working Group has a central database for ISC fisheries statistics which is an offline system now, although we will prepare the developed online system in March 2006.

Category I data related with marlins and swordfish fisheries are stored in the ISC database. The latest category I data by country/entity are shown in Table 1 for catch and Table 2 for effort. They were collected from the National reports submitted to the ISC plenary meetings, and has been revised by the updates data provided from a data correspondent of each ISC member.

No Category II and III data are stored in the ISC database. ALB- WG tries to change their data formats to ISC data format, although they have Category II data including the fisheries related with marlins and swordfish.
